

Abstract template:

The maximum size of posters is 1000 mm wide x 1500 mm high (i.e. portrait format).

- Authors names in bold, with surname first followed by full first name and second initial. Presenting author indicated with an asterisk after surname. Example: **Beekhuijzen*¹ Manon, Mantovani² Alberto, Barrow³ Paul**. Failure to follow this format will result in incorrect indexing in the journal.
- Affiliation in italics, name of institute, place and country only. Multiple affiliations indicated by superscript numbers after surnames.
- One line spacing before body text.
- Abstract body in plain text in one paragraph, no indents or empty lines. No figures or Tables.
- Up to three references may be cited indicated by numbers in square brackets in line with the text.
- The reference format of Reproductive Toxicology should be used (<http://www.elsevier.com/journals/reproductive-toxicology/0890-6238/guide-for-authors#68000>).
- Organize text in: introduction, methods, results and conclusions. Provide factual text.
- Avoid general statements like: "results will be presented".
- Use 300 up to a **maximum of 500 words** for complete abstract (including title, authors, affiliation and text).
- Add preference choice for poster or oral presentation.
