



**Manon Beekhuijzen, PhD, ERT**

**Section Head General, Developmental and Reproductive Toxicology**

Ms. Manon Beekhuijzen studied Medical Biology at the Utrecht University. In 1999 she joined Charles River in the Netherlands as Study Director for developmental and reproduction toxicology (DART) studies. She was responsible for a major part in setting up all different type of DART and juvenile studies at this site. In 2014 she was promoted as section head DART (managing the DART study directors) and in 2018 this was extended to include the study directors of the general toxicology group.

She is registered as European Toxicologist (ERT), president of the Dutch Society of Toxicology subgroup DART, council member of the public affairs committee of the US Teratology Society (TS), and past-president of the European Teratology Society (ETS).

In the last years she published high-ranking papers in the field of the 3R's for DART. In 2018 she defended her thesis "DART: the next generation. Working towards optimal implementation of the 3R principles in regulatory DART testing".
